Catholic Central High School has remained a vibrant force of rich history and tradition in North Troy, since 1923. As a co-educational, college preparatory school educating over 300 students in grades 7-12, Catholic Central is the largest Diocesan high school in the Albany Diocese. More than 25,000 alumni strong, our graduates are regularly accepted into many of the nation's most prestigious colleges across the United States.

ACADEMICS

The Catholic Central academic program includes 3 different learning levels: Regents, Honors, Advanced Placement/University in the High School. These levels are designed to meet the individual needs of each student. In keeping with the education objectives of Catholic Central, every student will be expected to carry a full academic schedule each semester.

Theology is required for all students. Course requirements include four units of English, four units of social studies, three units of mathematics, three units of science, four years of physical education, one unit of language other than English,

one unit of business, one-half unit of health and one unit of art or music.

Catholic Central is part of the University in the High School program through the University at Albany. Courses are available in calculus, art, and Spanish. A course in marketing is part of the UHS program through Hudson Valley Community College. Students who participate in the UHS program receive college credit from the University at Albany or Hudson Valley Community College. AP credits are available in biology, chemistry, world history, US history, European history, Spanish and English.

The school promotes academic achievement within the context of Catholic/Christian values.
